Governing Body Meeting Terms of Reference 2024-2025

Objectives

- To agree constitutional matters, including procedures where the Governing Body has discretion
- To recruit new members as vacancies, arise and to appoint new governors where appropriate
- To hold at least three Governing Body meetings a year
- To elect or remove the Chair and Vice Chair
- To appoint or remove a Clerk to the Governing Body
- To suspend a Governor
- To establish the committees of the Governing Body and their terms of reference
- To appoint or remove a Chair of each committee
- To appoint or remove a Clerk to each committee
- To appoint, suspend or remove a Headteacher
- To make decisions on the alteration, closure or change of category of the school
- To oversee and keep under review all aspects of the school operation and development and to make decisions on matters that have not been delegated to a committee, group or individual
- To decide, review and approve annually which functions of the Governing Body will be delegated to committees, groups and individuals

- To receive reports from any individual or committee to whom a decision has been delegated and to consider whether any further action by the Governing Body is necessary
- To approve the School Development Plan and Prospectus
