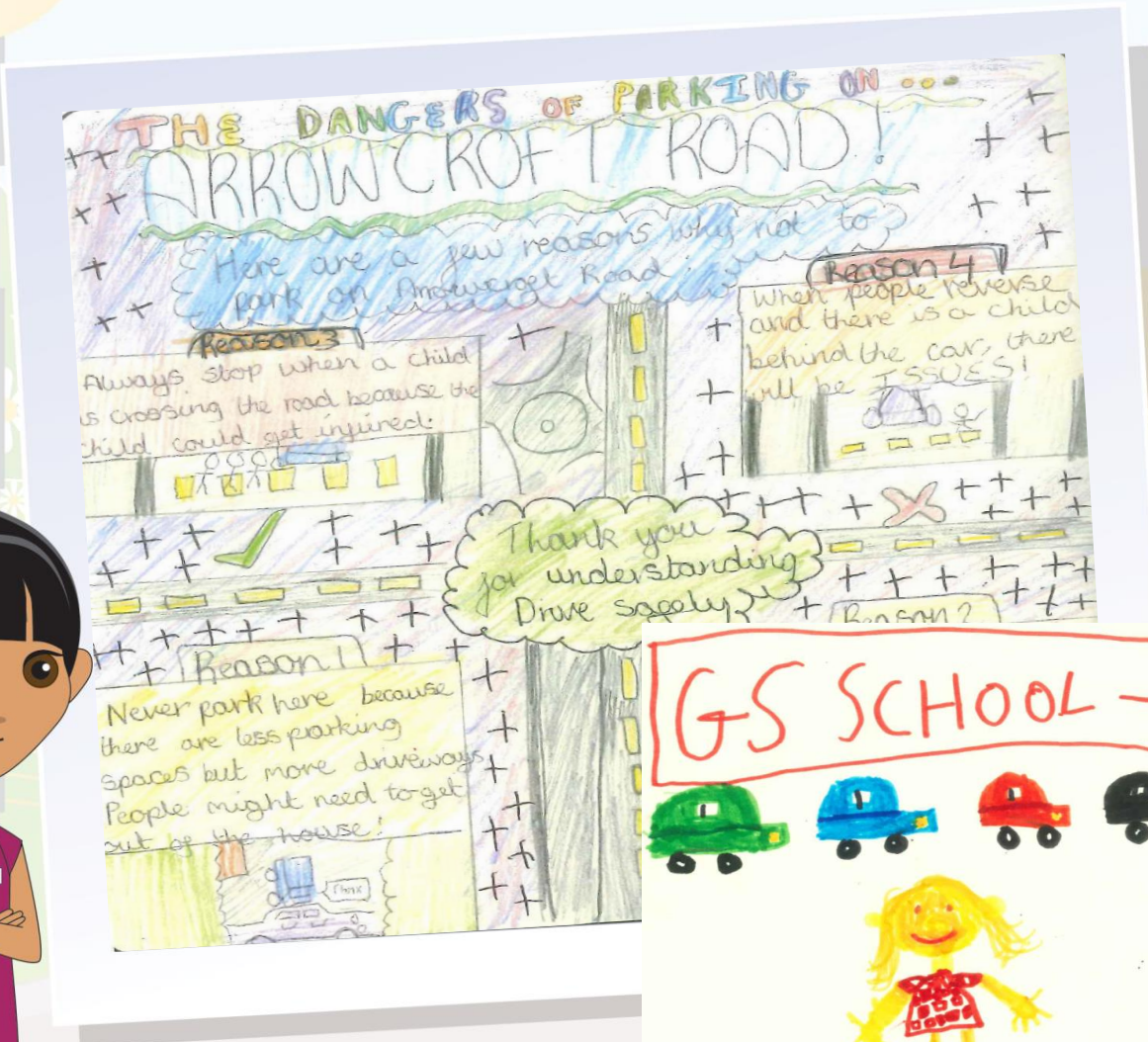

# PARENTS' SAFER PARKING CHARTER

The Junior Safety Officers and school have made a Safe Parking Charter. They want everyone who drives to Guilden Sutton CE Primary School to read and follow the Parking Charter to help keep all of the children safe. Please remember road safety is everyone's responsibility.

I agree to follow the rules of the Safer Parking Charter. By signing up to this charter I agree to:

- Drive safely, within the school area, and follow the speed limits, driving in agreement with the Highway Code.
- Leave in plenty of time for the school run and if possible park away from school and walk the rest of the way with my children to school. Walking is fun and a fantastic way to exercise.
- Not to park within 10metres of a junction.
- Don't park in a way that would block or cause issues at the school entrance, residents' driveways and junctions.
- Not drive on the pavement when stopping or parking, allowing pedestrians to be able to walk on pavements and space for prams to pass.
- Park so that my child is able to leave the vehicle on the pavement side away from any traffic.
- Not to use the staff car park as a pick up or drop off point for my children.

**If at all possible walk to School**

- Pay particular attention for other children at the side and rear of the vehicle when parking, dropping off or setting off.
- Avoid double parking, so as not to affect the flow of traffic or access for emergency vehicles.
- Respect local residents by not parking in a way that blocks access to their homes.
- Car share with friends to reduce the number of vehicles travelling to school - you could take it in turns to help reduce the demands of the school run.
- To talk about any concerns regarding dangerous parking and road safety in the school environment to the Head teacher or a Governor, who can then take suitable action.
- Let other people who pick up your child know of the best places to park and to avoid parking in Arrowcroft Road.
